**NOTICE INVITING AUCTION SALE – OF CONDEMNED SCRAP MATERIALS OF SOUTH BENGAL STATE
TRANSPORT CORPORATION A GOVERNMENT OF WEST BENGAL UNDERTAKING.**

Sealed Bids are hereby invited on "AS IS AND WHERE IS BASIS" by the South Bengal State Transport Corporation, from bonafide bidders for Auction sale of old and unserviceable lot of SCRAP MATERIALS lying at (1) Durgapur Divisional workshop, Dr. B.C.Roy Avenue, Durgapur-01.

All concerned are requested to visit the above mentioned address for necessary inspection and bidding as well as to the website of SBSTC, www.sbstc.co.in for information.

Terms and conditions of Auction Sale

1. The intending bidders should possess valid PAN, GST registration, valid Professional Tax Payment Certificate, current I.T. returns and GST Returns, current Trade Licenses and permits etc. Self attested scanned copies of all the documents as indicated above should be submitted for getting the approval of bidding. The photocopy of each will have to be submitted to the office of the South Bengal State Transport Corporation, Dr. B.C.Roy Avenue, Durgapur-01 latest by the 'DOCUMENT SUBMISSION/PAYMENT END DATE'. i.e. 15.07.25.
2. Reserve price for the lot has been fixed by the Competent Authority and the same has been kept confidential. The highest bidder will be considered on the basis of the Reserve price fixed by competent authority and not on the basis of the starting price.
3. Earnest Money amounting to Rs.10000.00(Rupees ten Thousand)only, to be deposited in the form of Bank Draft from any nationalized bank, drawn in favour of the "South Bengal State Transport Corporation", Payable at Durgapur, must be submitted along with the hard copies of above mentioned documents .Scanned copy of the DD to be submitted online in between 'DOCUMENT SUBMISSION/PAYMENT START DATE' i.e. 07.07.25 and DOCUMENT SUBMISSION/PAYMENT END DATE' i.e. 15.07.25.
4. After opening of the bids, earnest money of all intending bidders except highest bidder (H1) & Second highest bidder (H2) will be refunded, after due sanction is obtained from the competent authority. However earnest money of the second highest bidder (H2) will be refunded only after the RECEIPT OF ENITRE AMOUNT DUE ALONG WITH TAXES FROM H1 BIDDER . No bid will be accepted without the earnest money. Earnest Money of H1 bidder will be refunded after the issue of Delivery Order and after the receipt of report from the Works In Charge of respective Division. Any adverse report received from the works regarding any damage caused by H1 bidder while lifting the condemned items, may cause for deduction/forfeiture of earnest money. Any bidder who want to adjust the earnest money deposited by them in advance with the total amount to be deposited by them along with taxes and duties, may do so after the approval of their application in this respect.

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The details of the scrap items are as under.

1	Iron and MS items including damaged , rusted drums.	To be measured after uploading of scrap material by the H 1 bidders

3	Heap of debris along with cohesion less mixed soil.

5. In addition to the EMD, the H1 bidder has to deposit Rs1.50 lakh in advance after the issuance of acceptance letter for their bids. The said amount will be adjusted after final weighing of scrap materials after its uploading, failing which earnest money shall stand forfeited and the bidder shall be debarred from participating in any auction under South Bengal State Transport Corporation for a minimum period of one year.
6. The intending bidders must provide every detail as desired above including his name, address and Mobile no. and office land line no. if available, clearly in the space provided for the same - on line. Incomplete information may lead to rejection.
7. Auctioned materials to be collected from mentioned addresses at the purchaser's own arrangement (viz. scrap materials and manpower for loading). No expenses in any form towards disposal will be borne by the office.
8. Requisite Tax Invoice and delivery/lifting order for disposal will be provided by the concerned officers of SBSTC. However all other permits/permissions required for transportation and disposal will have to be arranged by the purchaser. Disposal of the dismantled materials/goods have to be arranged as per relevant traffic rules of the area. All such type of incidental costs have to be borne by the bidders.
9. The successful bidder at his own cost has to adopt all safety/preventive/precautionary measures following relevant rules of the Government for safe disposal of all scrap materials. Permission from appropriate authority if needed for such process has to be procured from the end of the bidder at his own cost failing which the earnest money of the bidder will be forfeited.
10. In general the highest bid above the Reserve Price fixed for the lots will be accepted. The rate quoted by the bidder above the Reserve Price will automatically achieve " SOLD " status. Rates quoted below 75% of Reserve Price will summarily be rejected and will achieve "Rejected" status. If the rates quoted are between 76% and 99%, it will be subjected to approval of the Competent Authority who will decide regarding the acceptance of such rate. However, the bid inviting authority shall not be bound to accept the highest bid in any of the three status and can go for subsequent calls if the highest bid in the opinion of the undersigned does not appear to be satisfactory, the undersigned reserves the right to call for fresh Auction and so on.
11. Condemned scrap materials and scrap materials lying at above mentioned locations may be viewed between 12.00 Hrs to 16.00 Hrs on any working day with the permission of the concerned Divisional Managers/ Depot Authorities of respective Divisions/ Depot. **The last date of inspection is on 15.07.25 up to 3.00 pm.**
12. All precautionary measures will be taken by the auctioneer so that no damage to any government property or personnel takes place. Under no circumstances, dismantling

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measures which can cause a fire hazard will be permitted. Any damage or loss of Government/public/private property or life during the dismantling/disposal process will be the sole responsibility of the successful bidder and the successful bidder has to replenish the cost of such damage at his own cost as per estimate prepared by this office, failing which the earnest money of the bidder will be forfeited following penal and legal actions.

13. The dates and times mentioned below are final and no request for any change will be entertained under any circumstances. Moreover, no objection in any form shall be entertained after completion of on line scrutiny of documents.
14. The order would be treated as valid for 60 (Sixty) days from the date of opening of the bids. The stipulated time may be extended for a further period considering untoward situations (e.g. due to lock down for and epidemic, pandemics, etc.). The lifting order (hard copy/soft copy), may be issued on any day within such 60 (Sixty) days period. The successful bidder has to complete the work in all respects within next 20 (Twenty) working days from the date of issuance of such lifting order. Lifting can be allowed beyond this 20 working days period subject to payment of ground rent @ 1% of quoted rate for the lots per week of delay. The Ground Rent may be adjusted with the EMD submitted by the bidders if they wish to do so.
15. If the bidder fails to lift the condemned items within the said period of 60 days of bid validity, the entire value of the lot will be forfeited. The bidder will not be allowed to lift the condemned items further.

16. It shall be deemed that all bidders have thoroughly read and understood the terms and conditions of sale before bidding. It will also be deemed that all the bidders have inspected the properties prior to auction and have satisfied themselves with the full particulars of the same. No objection or claim of any nature whatever shall be entertained at the conclusion of the auction. The on line bids to be submitted accordingly.
17. The H1 bidder will be solely responsible for sorting and necessary shifting of scrap material identification and measurements.
18. The H1 bidder shall assume all liability for, and keep SBSTC saved, harmless and indemnified against all actions or suits, claims, costs, damages, charges and expenses arising out of or in connection with the fulfillment of the terms and conditions of the sale, whether such actions, suits, or claims are brought by members of the public or workmen employed, provided, however, that he will not have to indemnify for any action that may be brought by a claimant and who may question the legal right of Govt. to dispose off the property.
19. Failure on the part of any bidder to observe and abide by any or all the above noted terms & conditions will disqualify himself to become eligible bidder and his earnest money or part thereof as necessary may stand forfeited.
20. The auction inviting authority reserves the right to accept or reject any or all of the bids without assigning any reason thereof.



21. All legal issues if any arising out of the above auction will be limited to Durgapur Jurisdiction only.
